#### 1. Facilities

#### 2. Radon

Silver Falls School District has a Radon Plan. The plan complies with ORS 332.167.

#### 3. Lead in Drinking Water

##### a. Testing

Water was tested for lead in drinking faucet outlets and sinks during the summer of 2016.

##### b. Mitigation

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has developed guidelines for lead in water titled '3T's for Reducing Lead in Drinking Water in Schools' (3T's). The EPA's action level to mitigate lead in school drinking and food preparation water is 20 ppb (parts per billion).

## Healthy and Safe Schools Plan – Silver Falls School District

The District will follow the EPA 3T's mitigation guidelines. Silver Falls School District has adopted a more aggressive action level to reduce lead in water when test results exceed 15 ppb.

The District will:

- i. Turn off drinking water outlets that have a 15 ppb or higher result.
  - ii. Replace fixtures that have results of 15 ppb or higher.
  - iii. Conduct follow-up testing after fixture replacement.
  - iv. If retest results are higher than 15 ppb, the water outlet will remain out of service and additional investigation will occur.
  - v. Provide bottled water where needed.
  - vi. Place signage at non-potable water sources stating the water should not be consumed. ( bathroom sinks, science room sinks, hose bibs, etc.)
  - vii. Use testing labs accredited by the Oregon Health Authority.
- c. Future Testing
- The District plans to test it's drinking and food prep water sources at regular intervals and is expecting the frequency to be legislated in the near future. There is no research stating how often school districts should test for lead in water.

### **4. Lead Paint**

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rules, Silver Falls School District will only contract work which will disturb lead paint with certified lead based paint renovation contractors that are licensed by the Oregon Construction Contractors Board. Minor work that may disturb Lead paint may also be performed by district staff that are trained and certified by the Oregon Health Authority to perform this work.

### **5. Integrated Pest Management (IPM)**

The District will make all test results available to the public within five (5) business days of receiving them. Results will be posted on the District website, and also made available for review in hardcopy at the District Administration Office located at:
