Our parent and community volunteers work in classrooms, read with students, chaperone field trips, and help facilitate special events. We have a strong Parent Teacher Club (PTC) which meets each month and is responsible for fundraising to provide student incentives, assist with student supplies, and support academic resources for our school when general fund monies are limited.

Academic Theme or Focus

Academically, we are committed to the goal of every child performing at grade level. We take pride in a master schedule, interventions, extensions, and enrichment activities, that challenge all students to reach their individual potential every day.

Our School is Special Because...

Mark Twain Elementary School is special because we are a PBIS School (Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports) that focuses on acknowledging and rewarding positive behavior in our students. We have an exceptional staff of educators who work together to positively impact social, emotional, and academic outcomes for every student. We work very hard to limit class sizes in Kindergarten at 20 students, and First/Second grade classrooms at 25 students throughout the school year to provide the best access to our staff. In addition to core academics for K-2 students, we also provide 150 Physical Education minutes weekly, 60 minutes per week of Library/Literacy lessons, utilize 1:1 iPad technology for every student, and fully staff Special Education and English Language Development Services, as well as Title I interventions in our building.
