Student learning will be our number one priority. All students will be on grade level. We will hold students accountable behaviorally and academically, with a primary focus on student attendance. We will strive for no more than 9 absences per student per year. We will create a positive and safe school culture where students and staff work together to create an awesome setting for education. We will have a sustainable educational setting where Victor Point is considered an exceptional school by our parents, community, students, school board, and staff. Student engagement within the classroom will be a primary focus for all staff with every lesson.

Parent / Community Involvement

Victor Point has a very active PTCC. The school holds three large fundraisers each year. These include the Annual Pie and Cake Auction in the fall and the Run for the Hills and Chili Feed in the spring. These three events typically raise more than \$20,000 which is used to fund special projects or events at school. In the last 10 years, the PTCC has purchased all new playground equipment and has helped fund a massive remodel of the school library, and computer lab. Over the next three years the PTCC will partner with the school and roughly spend \$60,000 on school technology that will help engage our students in the learning process.

Academic Theme or Focus

Victor Point has an extensive intervention program available to students at all grade levels who are struggling in the areas of reading or math. All of our instructional assistants are trained in providing supplemental program help. We run multiple intervention groups during the regular school day in addition to before and after school tutoring slots.

Our School is Special Because...

The school has retained its small community feel even in a larger sized rural school. There are many students who are multi-generational Victor Point students, meaning their parents and even grandparents attended school here. The staff is proud of their very strong academic program balanced with building strong character and solid citizenship skills.
