Engage: Technology, Learning, Community

Engage is engaging parents in education technology through seminars, discussions and community connections. There is a great shift in the learning process taking shape within our schools. Technology is facilitating a move towards a student centered approach to real world learning. Students are no longer limited by the walls of the classroom. With such a shift in learning and the resulting shift in student workflow, process and tools, comes a need for understanding and engagement from parents. Engage Oregon is meeting this critical need for engagement of parents in the process of technology as a learning tool in K12 districts across the state.

The half-day conference is modeled after the [Educate Engage Conference](#) presented by Melissa Lim of Portland Public Schools in March 2016 and the [ENGAGE 2015 Parent Tech Conference](#) presented by Ben Grey's group in Illinois. The conference is being "packaged" in a series of document and web templates where it may be replicated across the state by a strong community of education technology leaders.
