



Therapeutic Education Program

Our focus is providing for a full Oregon diploma and supporting happy, healthy teens with comprehensive mental and behavioral health support to build hope, success and wellbeing through education and advocacy.

Our program brings together the best in education, health care, and community to provide the personalized support each student needs in pursuit of a bright and successful future.

Our program serves students grades 7-12 from regional school districts who are committed to success high school and beyond, but lack the mental or behavioral health, skills, or resources to thrive in a traditional school setting.

This is not a lock-in facility but is a therapeutic education placement where students can learn the academic, social-emotional, and life skills they need to lead a happy and productive life in a personalized learning environment that works with the often complex lives and needs of our most vulnerable students.

In addition to a full academic curriculum, this program provides:

- Comprehensive Case Management
- On Site Mental and Behavioral Health Services
- Resource Coordination and System Navigation
- Life Skills Training
- Supportive Educational Culture
- Transition Services

Students appropriate for this level of service will:

- Have demonstrated a lack of response to less intensive interventions
- Often have multiple or complex challenges
- Be willing to actively engaged in treatment
- Be committed to graduating from high school and successfully transitioning post-graduation
- Have difficulty maintaining behaviors in a regular classroom setting
- Have experienced a significant disruption in level of functioning for an extended period of time (typically more than 6 months)

Students of this program may be experiencing one or more of the following:

- Mental and Behavioral Health Needs
- Poverty, Homelessness, Family Instability
- Prolonged Family Crisis
- Trauma
- System Alienation
