3. Elevated Levels of Lead in Water used for Drinking or Food preparation

All school districts, education service districts, and public charter schools are required to test for and eliminate exposure to elevated levels of lead in water used for Drinking and Food Preparation through either remediation or eliminating access, according to OAR 333-061-0400 and OAR 581-022-2223. In conformance with those administrative rules, Silver Falls School District certifies the following:

- A. All testing was done according to the testing requirements in OAR 333-061-0400;
- B. All samples were analyzed by a lab accredited by Oregon Health Authority to test for those materials;
- C. All water fixtures required to be tested under OAR 333-061-0400 were tested for elevated levels of lead in accordance with the testing schedule developed by the Oregon Health Authority, and the testing schedule for each building covered by this plan is set forth in the following table:

4. Lead Paint

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency’s Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rules, Silver Falls School District will only contract work which will disturb lead paint with certified lead based paint renovation contractors that are licensed by the Oregon Construction Contractors Board. Minor work that may disturb Lead paint may also be performed by district staff that are trained by the district renovator who has been trained, certified and is registered with the Oregon Health Authority to perform this work. 5. Asbestos

Silver Falls school District Complies with the federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency response Act (AHERA). All required asbestos management plans are available for viewing by submitting a request to the Director of Maintenance and Facilities.

6. Radon
